Aim: To make action plan of energy saving

Action

- Upgrade light bulbs in the Boarding House
- Install Thermostatic control on the boilers in Senior School and Boarding House
- 3. Replace pool cover
- 4. Re-commission space heating and temperature control in the Barn
- 5. Install voltage optimiser for incoming electricity
- 6. Try TRV on radiators in Senior & Lower School
- 7. Replace Lower School boiler
- Install control on fluorescent lighting except in the Boarding House

Review: Each term

- Raise awareness of Staff and pupils Lights on / off; Computers on / off......
- Monitor energy consumption through invoices
- Read meters weekly / monthly
- Set targets for reduction 4%
- Presentations to staff and pupils about energy saving measures
- Regularly ask staff where energy can be saved in their area
- Obtain and put up stickers from Carbon Trust etc
