The online GoCardLess system has been set up for the future purchase of tickets.

The website will redirect you to GoCardLess where it will ask for your details and you will be able to complete the purchase for any tickets.

Your registration will be approved by the PTA. Mrs Dorling will receive the information and will only be able to see registration details but will not have access to any card information as this will remain confidential to the site. When your registration is approved you will then be able to select the tickets required and proceed to payment.

**The General Data Protection Data (GDPR)** comes into effect on the 15<sup>th</sup> May 2018 and requires

businesses to seek permission to send out information and to assure clients that data has been stored responsibly. Obviously as a school we need to keep you informed and our method of transferring information is via email. The PTA sometimes asks the office to send out information on their behalf as they do not have access to the database and do not store individual parents' data.

The GDPR is very topical at the moment and causing businesses extra work in gaining permission to send out information. We are in the process of updating our Data Protection Policy which will be on the website by the 15<sup>th</sup> May.

The medical forms sent out annually contains all permissions and consents and these will be distributed shortly and will include an opportunity to give permission for contacting you via emails.

Obviously signing up to face book, twitter and other social media is done with your consent.
